

Guide to Completing the Online Application for Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) Training

General Instructions

1. Please submit one application per agency listing all participating therapists. Application must be completed by agency director or authorized individual.
2. Before completing application, please review the following documents and be sure that your agency can meet the requirements for implementation:

3. As the online application must be completed at one time, be sure to have the following information available before completing the application:

 - Information for each participating therapist, including: Name, Email, Education level, if therapist is actively treating children ages 2-7 with behavioral problems

Selection Guidelines

1. Preference for training openings is given to agencies that request training for more than one therapist, meet all requirements for implementation, and serve underserved areas of the state (where there are no or few PCIT-trained therapists). Trainings are open to Arkansas-based therapists only.
2. Openings for each training cohort is limited. Once a training is full, interested participants will be put on a list to receive information on future PCIT trainings.
